

LITSCHER SLEDDING HILL

RULES

The following regulations apply at the Litscher Sledding Hill:

1. Sledding Hill Hours are from dawn to dusk, conditions permitting.
2. The Sledding Hill will not be staffed and the Sauk Prairie Parks and Recreation Department encourages users to sled at their own risk.
3. Carefully walk up the hill watching for other patrons on sleds.
4. Make sure your sledding path is clear before proceeding down the hill.
5. Be considerate to others, keep a safe distance from others when sledding.
6. Sled in a **SITTING** position only. No “surfing, skiing, or snowboarding” is allowed.
7. Use of a helmet is strongly recommended, but not required.
8. Building jumps or ramps is **NOT** allowed.
9. Sledding is allowed in designated area only. Do **NOT** sled towards Westwynde homes/North of the hill.
10. If the hill is posted as **CLOSED**, then sledding is prohibited due to weather/surface conditions.
11. Tuck in any scarves, strings, or long hats that could potentially catch on any obstruction and cause strangulation or other serious injuries.
12. Only plastic sleds and snow tubes are allowed on the sled hill. Saucers, toboggans, and all sleds with metal runners are prohibited.
13. Bikes, scooters, wheel riders and/or motorized equipment are **NOT** allowed.
14. Parents/guardians are responsible for their children.
15. Pets are prohibited on the hill.
16. Smoking and alcohol use is prohibited.
17. **Call 911 for Emergencies.**

Please Follow the Above Rules.

The Sauk Prairie Park and Recreation Department staff reserves the right to enforce all park rules. Failure to obey rules may result in dismissal from the park premises.
